Wisemans Hotel was once the grand old residence of Solomon Wiseman. Built in 1826 by convict labour, it is constructed from hand-huened Hawkesbury sandstone and now forms the main part of the hotel. The frontage towards the river shows the Georgian style five-opening symmetry on both stories, a stone arch gracing fanlight above the front door, shaped stone lintels over the windows and an elaborate seven-tiered semi-circular flight of steps. The hotel has five original fire-places, four of which are still in operation today giving the winter months a stunning old world ambience. The hotel has many old fittings and chattels, photographs provided by the historical society and very interesting reading material throughout the hotel
